



MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE (6-8TH GRADE)

Middle School uniforms should be purchased at **Risse Brothers**. Middle School (6-8) students wear black or brass-colored polo with the Orlando Science Schools logo and khaki, navy, or jean bottoms. Shoes must be closed-toed dress shoes, or athletic shoes. No special designs, patterns (Checkered, plaid, camouflage, etc.), or wild colors are permitted. Shoes must be worn at all times. Belts must be leather, braided leather, or fabric in solid colors of black, brown, khaki, or navy blue. NO Rolling Backpacks. Students are expected to wear the school uniform at all times and to dress and groom themselves in such a way as to reflect neatness, cleanliness, and safety.

Dress Code: Tops

Top Options: Black/Brass Polo or long-sleeved shirt with school logo from Risse Brothers.

**From the 2025-2026 School Year onwards, Middle School Students will transition to a Black/Brass color scheme. While current Middle School Students can continue wearing their existing Red/Navy shirts, these colors will no longer be available for purchase as a Middle School option.*

During wintertime, long sleeve/turtleneck may be worn under the knit/polo shirt as long as it is the school appropriate color (blue, tan, black, or white).



Dress Code: Pants

Pants and shorts must be either khaki, navy blue or jeans. They must have belt loops and a belt must be worn through the loops and fastened appropriately. Cargo pants or shorts are **not** allowed.

Dress Code: Skirts

Skirts must be either khaki or navy blue.



Dress Code: Shoes

Shoes must be closed-toe dress or athletic style. No special designs or patterns (checkered, plaid, camouflage, etc.) or wild colors (fluorescent) are permitted.

The emphasis regarding shoes is safety. All shoelaces must be tied properly.

Slippers, flip-flops, boots, Uggs, and high-heeled shoes **are not permitted**.

Dress Code: Physical Education

The PE uniform is only for middle schoolers. Students changing for PE can wear the uniform like the one below or their regular uniform. The PE uniform can be purchased at the uniform store. PE uniform must be labeled with the student's full name.



Dress Code: Fall/Winter

Additional fall /winter clothing, including jackets that violate the school dress code, winter hats, gloves, etc., may be worn, but must be removed upon entering the building and stored in the student's backpack.

It is very important to label all jackets, lunch boxes, water bottles, and uniform clothing with the student's name and grade. In that way, if it is lost in the school, it can be returned to the right person.
