Mission/Vision Statement & Core Values

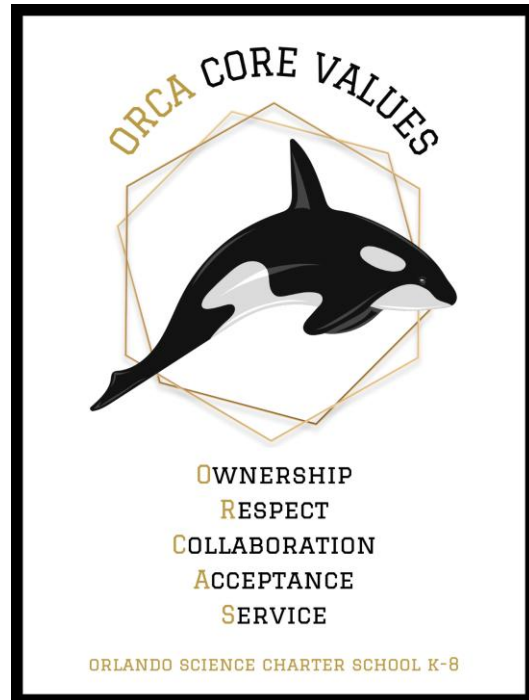
The **mission** of Orlando Science East Campus is to empower all students with a STEM education which will help them reach their maximum potential and guide them to a promising and successful career.
